Note for 6th, 7th & 8th families

To avoid heavy traffic and prevent congestion during pick up times, it is suggested that rides for older students arrive between 3:25-3:30pm, M-Th, and closer to 1pm on Fridays.

School Speed Zone

Just a reminder that we are on a residential street and a school speed zone of 20mph during the hours of 7am-5pm. Please be respectful of our neighbors and follow the posted speeds.

Communicate COVID Exposure

If your child has had a COVID-19 exposure or if a family member tests positive, PLEASE contact Mrs. Cornette. HVAS must follow the protocols provided in the *Ready Schools Safe Learners* guidance as well as advice from the local public health authority regarding quarantine. Since Mrs. Cornette is HVAS's safety officer, per our Operational Blueprint, it is important that she keeps accurate records of COVID exposures and COVID cases among our students and staff. Further, Mrs. Cornette will advise as far as length of quarantine or isolation before returning to school, as applicable.
